

So here are some of the hints for your Biblical Fiction Research...

- Start with the Bible
- Find out related scriptures to the one you have started with
- Research the culture of the times.
 - (I have read some 'good' stories but the research only goes back to what was current in the Middle Ages.)
- Go back further.
 - Before the Babylonian captivity of Judah and after it there were many differences. Know which time you are researching.
- Try to put yourself in the shoes and location of the person you are writing about.

This could be none of the following...

- Phone,
- Vehicle,
- Modern cooker,
- Electricity,
- Supermarkets,
- Grinding your own flour,
- Hand sewing clothes and household linen.
- Walking to the markets and choosing food, grain, material
- Moreover, little or no contact with the person your character will marry, not even after a betrothal.
 - Even though the betrothed couple stayed in the homes of their own families until the marriage, a betrothal could only be broken by a divorce.

Most important...

Write with the best understanding of the time and culture of your story, not looking back from our modern perspective.
